### ***Seeds of True Self: Recovering Wholeness and Integrity in Christ***

Spring is a season for planting seeds and delighting in new buds. It is also the season for attending to the great paradox of Christian Life: in the logic of God's love, death begets life.

During this retreat, we will ponder the seeds of true self - the reality of inner truth God planted in each of us long ago - and clues we find within to help us recover the integrity and beauty of that divinely given wholeness. We will also pay attention to the disheartening experience of feeling ourselves inwardly divided and scattered in response to external demands and expectations. What spiritual practices might help us recover the depths of our integrity and wholeness, personally and professionally? How do we experience more fully the relationship between New Creation in Christ and our own renewed selfhood? Perhaps we will glimpse buds of new possibility forming within and among us.
