How do you answer this question? That is what really matters. We can not answer yes can we?

The question might even be are any clergy blameless? I suspect, that if we are honest in our personal reflection, we would agree that we can not answer yes.

We all have errors of omission and commission. Some of our actions have been intentional, some unintentional.

Some of those things we are responsible for have not caught anyone's attention; others have been the material of public chargeable offenses.

We may not even be aware of the ways in which what we do has adversely affected colleagues, family, friends and churches. To the extent that we are aware we have responded

unevenly. When confronted with the ways in which our actions have contributed to breaking the body of Christ, have we accepted responsibility and taken the opportunity to experience God's grace and learn?

When our actions have torn our covenant, my prayer is that we will

take the opportunity to reflect, to repent, to learn and act in another way. In so far as the question gives us pause to reflect before we are the cause for broken relationships, I pray awareness, for God's grace and direction.

What would happen if the answer was a simple no? Would it catch our attention? Would it effect any change? Would we immediately think of the ways in which we know our sisters and brothers have been anything but blameless? Can you think of places in your ministry where you need to be accountable and contrite? I can think about places in my ministry where this is so. Considering the question in community, with all of you, as colleagues, is a particularly important task.

Let us hold each other in prayer so that all of us might be faithful disciples as we witness to the Gospel.

Would that we could answer Question 17 with a resounding yes and move on to other business. But we can't answer yes and we can't move on quickly to other business or continue business as usual. Perhaps that's the whole purpose of the question — to force us to consider, in the company of colleagues, the reality of our ministries.

Can our lives and our official administration be transparent Can we minister without fear of being "found out"? Is our behavior appropriate? Are our intentions ethical? Is our compassion authentic? If we, with God's grace, move in these directions, we can come to this part of our Holy without apprehension and we can sing David Haas' hymn as a description of our ministry together. Won't you join me in that prayer as we sing "We Are Called" (TFWS #2172)
